



#### **TxDOT Rail Division**



TxDOT Rail Division implements rail-related policies, performs infrastructure and operational analysis and rail project planning, monitors potential rail line abandonments, oversees railhighway safety and rail inspections, and manages the South Orient Railroad.

### **2024 Priorities: IIJA Xing Grants**

- \$570M nationwide RCE FY 22, Texas-related projects receive 20%
- All 3 TxDOT-prepared grade separation 2022 targets won awards
- Working now with FRA, planning 3 grade separation applications
- Focus on state priorities where state funding is difficult to apply

- \$20M award




### **2023 Priorities: South Orient International Trade**



- NII Equipment ordered with expected delivery in late summer.
- CBP facility let in March and was approved by commission.
- Construction anticipated to begin in June.


HDR has reached out to railroads across the state on behalf of TxDOT


#### **Revisions from 2019 Texas Rail Plan**

- Identification of New and Future Freight Rail Projects
  - Coordination with Class 1 RRs (BNSF, UP, CPKC)
  - Coordination with Class 3 RRs
- Identification of New and Future Passenger Rail
   Projects



### **Texas Triangle Passenger Rail**

- Step 1 Project scoping and scheduling for SDP (Pending FRA contract agreement) which makes \$500K funding available.
- **Step 2** Service development planning 90/10 state federal match.
- **Step 3** Possible construction grants 80/20 state federal match.



#### **Other Passenger Rail Expansions**



- I-20 corridor through the meridian speedway connecting Atlanta to DFW
- Heartland flyer expansion into Newton KS
- Texas Central Railway
